**Program Overview:**

- *STEM* – providing equipment for STEM Labs in elementary schools
- *YES! Grants for Teachers* – enriching programs teachers find most effective
- *Community Fund* – providing students with health screenings, glasses, and other medical needs
- *Care Share* – furnishing coats, shoes, and Christmas presents for PC families in need

## What We Have Done

- Provided 15 eye exams/pairs of glasses to children

- Increase adult English language learners by 20%
- Put another \$15,000 back into the schools through YES! Grants
- Improve CareShare to help more children in need
