

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS



Early Birds

Invested **\$10,000** in school readiness classes that taught **1,520** parents how to be their child's first teacher, setting up children for success in kindergarten and a lifetime of learning.

STEM

Laid the foundation for **3,800** students to explore and prepare for 21st century jobs by funding **\$21,500** for STEM Labs at **12** elementary schools.



English Language Literacy

Provided **\$23,000** in funding to help **85** adults learn English through a financial literacy and civics curriculum. Participants report better job prospects and better communication with their children's teachers.

Awarded **43 YES! Grants** to teachers totalling **\$25,764** and impacting over **16,000** children.

CareShare adopted 1,239 children from 430 families at Christmastime. Penny's Closet provided 325 coats and 216 pairs of shoes to children in need.

Awards & Recognition Recognized outstanding staff and patrons through Golden Apple awards, Excellent Educator/ Teacher of the Year, and Super Star Teacher awards.

Scholarships totalling **\$6,000** were awarded to **11** students and faculty members.



Community Fund provided **44** pairs of glasses and eye exams to children and assisted families with emergency funds to help after fire or flood. Funded membership in School Nurses Association for **77** district nurses.
