- *YES! Grants for Teachers* – underwriting programs teachers find most effective
- *Community Fund* – supporting students with health screenings, glasses, and other medical needs
- *CareShare/Penny’s Closet* – furnishing coats, shoes, and Christmas presents for PC families in need

What We Have Done

- Provided 325 coats and 216 pairs of shoes to children in need
- Fully funded the STEM Lab program in 12 elementary schools
- Gave 1,239 children hope at Christmastime through CareShare adoptions
- Recognized early-career educators through the Super Star Awards
- Funded over \$25,000 in YES! Grants to teachers
- Supported 85+ parents in their efforts to learn English
- Awarded over \$5,000 in scholarships to students and teachers
- Honored our best educators through Teacher of the Year Awards
- Helped over 1,520 parents become their child's first teacher through Early Birds
- Provided 44 eye exams/pairs of glasses to children

What We Want to Do

- Extend the STEM Lab program to all 18 elementary schools
- Maintain the strength of the Early Birds program
- Increase adult English language learners by 20%
- Put another \$15,000 back into the schools through YES! Grants
- Improve CareShare to help more children in need
